The Kannada rhyme "ಬೆಂಡೆ ಕಾಯಿ ತೊಂಡೆ ಕಾಯಿ" is a playful children's song often used in early learning settings. The title refers to two vegetables: *bendekai* (okra/lady's finger) and *tondekai* (ivy gourd).
